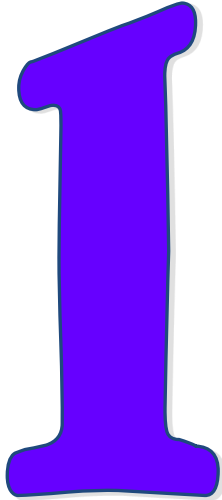
7 WAYS TO EMBRACE YOUR TRUE IDENTITY IN CHRIST.

Discover what the Word of God says about you.



The Word of God is filled with His promises to you as a Believer! You will never discover your true identity in Christ, if you do not spend quality time fellowshiping with God and searching the scriptures to discover what God says about you in His Word.

I will praise You, for I am fearfully and wonderfully made: Marvelous are your works, and that my soul knows very well.



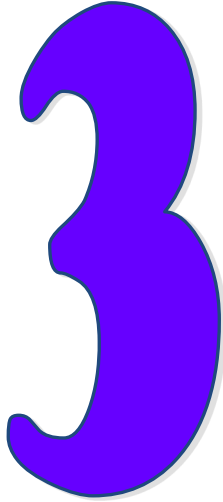
Replace all old negative tapes (thoughts) you've rehearsed for years with positive uplifting thoughts straight from the Word of God.

Embrace the fact that God's Word is final authority in your life! Anything that is contrary to the truth from Word of God has to be regarded as a lie. These untruthful thoughts must be replaced with the truth from God's Word.

We break down every thought and proud thing that puts itself up against the wisdom of God. We take hold of every thought and make it obey Christ.

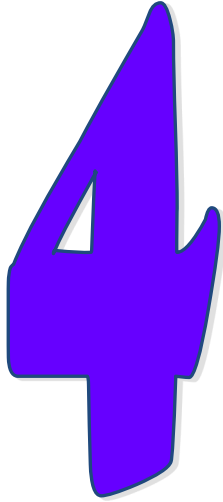
Confess the Word of God about you over and over again.



Begin to confess the Word of God over and over until you really believe that God is speaking to you! If you're going to embrace your true identity in Christ you must BELIEVE that the Word of God is true. No more questioning whether it applies to you or not. Settle it, the Word does apply to you and you will walk in all that it says about you. Be consistent and watch things begin to change as you confess what God says about you! I love it!

Reject ANY thought or word that is contrary to what God's Word says about you.

This step is strategic! To embrace your true identity you must daily cast down any thought that does not agree with God's Word about you. This step is strategic because the enemy will try to bombard your mind with things that will contradict the Word of God. Let heaven flood your thoughts!

Finally, brothers and sisters, whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable—if anything is excellent or praiseworthy—think about such things.

² Let heaven fill your thoughts; don't spend your time worrying about things down here.

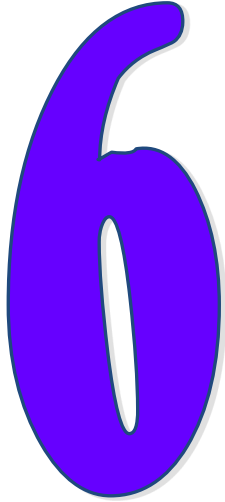
Guard your Heart, Eyes, Ears and Mouth.



In this step what you feel, see, hear and say will have an impact on your true identity in Christ. You must deal with heart issues that may have held you bound in the past. Forgiveness is for you, not the other person. Watching what you put before you eyes is another area to guard. Some things that we watch unconsciously challenges our beliefs about ourselves. Guard what you hear and say, because your words have power. To embrace your true identity you can't afford to start repeating things that your hear that do not line-up with God's Word! The bible says, "Life and death are in the power of your tongue and you will eat the fruit of it."

Psalm 141:3 Set a watch, O Lord, before my mouth; keep the door of my lips

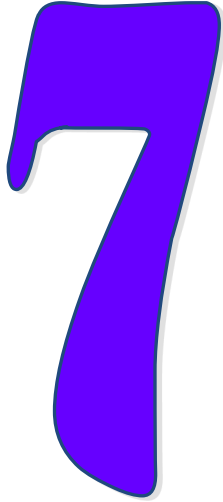


Begin to Spend Quality Time with God in Prayer, Reading the Word and Meditating on the Word.
