### How to use this Prayer Journal:

This 10 Day Purpose Driven Prayer journal I created specifically for you has a verse to meditate on throughout the day. I would even recommend that you type out the verse and put it as a reminder notification on your phone. This is a great reminder to keep your eyes on your amazing Creator throughout the day. Then before you go to bed, just sit and reflect on any additional thoughts you had during the day.

The "*Thoughts to ponder*" section can be a powerful tool! In the morning think of one small idea/thing you can implement into or change in your life today. Small 1% changes each day can lead to a 365 degree transformation over a year!

I am a firm believer that an *attitude of gratitude* is the KEY to an abundant life. You can't be mad, discontent or angry AND grateful at the same time!! Start your morning listing out 5-10 things you are grateful and thankful for. Say them out loud and feel the overwhelming gratefulness well up in your heart.



Lastly, but just as important, list out any prayers requests you have and thank the Lord for answering them in His perfect timing.

This journal is intended to help you start connecting with your passions and purpose... the potential you have to create the abundant life God has planned for you, so you can impact your family, career, relationships and the world.

I KNOW how it feels to be "lost", discontent, have fear and self-doubt ALONG with the feeling that there has to be more...I was created for so MUCH more! That was me a few years ago!
